## Legacy Giving

Leaving a charitable gift in your will can leave a lasting legacy and help create a more positive future for children with disabilities. Our small charity is very grateful for any gift left in a will, no matter how big or small.

You can leave a gift to Malvern Special families through your will and its value will be deducted from your estate (your money, possessions and property) before Inheritance Tax is worked out.

If your estate is liable to Inheritance Tax, you could reduce the amount due by choosing to give money to charity. You can either leave a fixed sum (known as a 'Pecuniary Legacy'), or part or all of your estate once other gifts have been distributed (known as a 'Residuary Legacy').

You can get free and independent advice about making a will from organisations like Citizens Advice and Age Concern. It is a good idea to use a solicitor, or have a solicitor check a will that you have drawn up, to ensure that it's valid and that your wishes are carried out.
